

RECOMMENDED FISHING GEAR LIST

Fly Rods: 3–4 wt. rods with a floating line would be great for out streams and the Firesteel River. 5-6 wt. rods are recommended for our trophy and float tube lakes and hard rod/reel cases for safe travel in planes.

Lines: Floating –WF, Sink Tip – 10' Slow/Intermediate, Sinking-Intermediate/Fast Sink

Reels: Single action trout fly reel

Leaders: 9 ft. tapered 4-6x (assortment); extra tippet material essential

Accessories: Clamp or needle nose pliers to release fish and to mash down barbs – Ketchum Release, Nippers, fly floating and tippet material (3-6x)

CLOTHING AND GEAR

Waders: Neoprene chest waders are recommended for float tubes and colder days. However, lightweight breathable waders are comfortable for stream fishing and warmer days. Expect to spend up to 6 hours in your waders daily.

Wading Boots: Cleats and studded boots are very hard on the planes and best to be avoided. Although unnecessary in our gravel bottom areas, if you feel the need to have studded boots, we ask that you simply change from lightweight shoes/sandals. Rubber or felt soled boots are preferred. To minimize the introduction of invasive species and disease, we will be providing a service to disinfect all wading boots and waders upon arrival.

Clothing: Good quality rain gear, warm fleece-type jacket or sweater, wide-brimmed hat, fingerless gloves, and poly gloves for warmth, long underwear, 4 pairs wool socks, 2-3 pair light socks, 4 cotton or light wool shirts, 2-3 pair of trousers, and camp shoes.

Other Items: Flashlight, camera, toiletries and medications, reading material, water bottle, polarized sunglasses; sunscreen; and insect repellent, and liquor (complimentary glass of wine is served with dinner).

Baggage Allowance: 60 lbs (36kg) per person, due to space available on aircraft and safety weight restrictions.
